#### What is RTI?

RTI is a process that provides high-quality research based instruction and interventions that are matched to students' academic and behavioral needs based on universal screening.

### What is the purpose of RTI?

The purpose is to address students' learning difficulties by focusing on how schools identify and respond to students' academic/behavior difficulties by using a problem solving, multitiered intervention strategy.

### What are the potential benefits of RTI?

One of the strongest benefits of an RTI approach is that is eliminates a "wait to fail" situation because students get assistance at their level of need promptly within the general education setting.

Each school has a RTI team. The purpose of the team is to assist the teacher. The team suggests additional strategies if needed and/or determines if the student needs to be placed in one of the tiers based on results of progress monitoring.
