ZVLP | Virtual Learning Program



Overview

ZVLP is an alternative to traditional public school, where students access standards-based courses facilitated by highly qualified/certified instructors online. Courses can be completed through a varied pace curriculum that is solely aligned to an individual student's ability. The courses can be completed anytime/anywhere and are progress monitored through a series of benchmark tests as well as a culminating exam that proves mastery of the content. All courses enable the student to be in direct contact with their facilitator through email, phone, Zoom, and/or face-to-face interaction.

Criteria

- 2.0 GPA- current and past
- Non-truant
- No chronic discipline issues
- LEAP score review
- Online application

Attendance requirements

- Must stay on target weekly
- In-person testing (state, unit test, and exams)
- Off-track students will meet to discuss a plan

Curriculum

- Standards-based Imagine Learning Online Platform
- Select DE and AP courses offered
- Individualized plan provided by your ZCSD counselor
- Direct instruction by highly qualified teachers
- On-demand feedback/online tutorials
- Classes accommodated as needed
- Grades issued by the ZCSD
- Includes ACT, Hi-Set, and LEAP prep

Academic Progress

- Daily and weekly progress & updates on grades
- Certified staff with daily office hours
- Session logs and progress are checked daily
- Consistent communication

Hybrid Option

- Attend two classes on campus
- Must have a current ID
- Provide own transportation
- Must have a parking tag (ZHS)
- Check in/check out
- ZCSD uniform
- All district and school policies apply
 - 2nd referral = return to in-person learning
- Attend during the class period the class is offered
- Cannot remain on campus after the class
- Students may participate in sports/clubs/extras
- Must be on track in online classes to participate

- Navigate 360 – counseling app
- Scope and Sequence
- Extra test prep
- Various meeting dates and times
- In-person/virtual tutoring and office hours

Additional Information

- Students cannot go virtual midsemester
- New students to ZCSD – must enroll within one week of start date
- Students cannot move back and forth between options.
