<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Traditional face-to-face learning • Classroom-based • 2 days in-person learning and 3 days at-home learning • Monday & Wednesday = Last name A - K • Tuesday & Thursday = Last name L - Z • Friday = Virtual day for all students • On days where students are not on campus, students will log in to their teacher's Moodle page to receive their instructions/assignments for the day. • On Friday, students are expected to follow their schedule and attend each class virtually during their scheduled class time. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100% Virtual learning • Students will follow Zachary High School's bell schedule. • The school day will begin at 7:00 AM and end at 2:12 PM. • Students will receive a schedule and be assigned a teacher for their courses, as normal. • Students will receive a lunch break as determined by their 5th hr period. • Students are expected to attend each course virtually, Monday through Friday, during their scheduled class time. • To allow for flexibility with the virtual days, video lessons will be recorded and posted. • Attendance will be taken for each class, as normal. • Teachers will deliver the lesson during a live video session for approximately 30-35 minutes. Students will then work independently or in small groups, virtually.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The first day of school for all students is Monday, August 10. • All students, except seniors in some cases, will have 7 classes. • Virtual students will be exposed to the same high-quality curriculum, pacing, and expectations of all students taking the course. • Please contact the teacher(s) if there are special circumstances in which the student cannot "meet" during the scheduled class time. • All virtual courses will have the same grading policies as the face-to-face version of the course. • All graded assignments and assessments will be included in the gradebook, as normal. • The grading and credit earned will NOT follow the policies of Spring, 2020. • ZHS is organizing material distribution days for our virtual students to receive the necessary materials for specific courses. • Teachers will have tutoring/office hours scheduled. 	

Hybrid & Virtual Learning Expectations

Students

- Know your schedule by logging into Parent Command Center on Thursday, August 6.
- Hybrid students: Printed schedules will also be available on the first day of school.
- Virtual students: Printed schedules can also be picked up at ZHS on Thursday, August 6.
 - Virtual students only—Last name A – K = 8:00 AM – 10:30 AM
 - Virtual students only—Last name L – Z = 10:30 AM – 1:00 PM
- Check your Zachary Schools email account daily and be able to access Teams.
- Log in daily through Clever.com to access Moodle, Zoom, Edgenuity, and more.
- Log in instructions are attached.
- Check Moodle daily for classwork, upcoming assignments, projects, and assessments.
- Establish a physical work space for yourself that is quiet, with minimal distractions.
- Follow Zachary High School's bell schedule. An example is provided.
- Attendance will be taken daily.
- Engage in the lessons provided by your teachers during the designated class times.
- Complete your assignments on time.
- Monitor your grades on Parent Command Center.
- Attend teacher office hours as needed and communicate proactively with your teachers if you need additional support.
- Reflect on provided feedback.
- If a student begins the school year in the virtual learning program, then he/she is expected to continue with the virtual learning program through the end of the first semester. In January, there will be an option to return to face-to-face instruction at ZHS.
- Act quickly to get help from the MIS Technology Help desk when encountering technical difficulties.
- Comply with ZCSD's Internet Acceptable Use Policy.

Parents & Families

Clever & Moodle Instructions:

- Clever is the log in portal for the digital resources for all ZHS students.
- Moodle is the site where all teachers will have their assignments posted.
- Go to the website: **clever.com**
- In the top right corner, click “Log in as a student”
- Search for Zachary High School and then log in with your school email address and password.
- On the home page in Clever, you should see many programs listed, such as Moodle and Edgenuity.
- Click on Moodle. You should be signed in automatically, and then it will bring you to the Moodle home page.
- On this page, students are able to access their email (Microsoft Outlook), Microsoft Teams, One Drive, and their teachers’ Moodle pages.

JPAMS Parent Command Center Instructions:


